Registration Agreement
Grades 1 – 6

THIS PROGRAM IS FOR BALDWIN SCHOOL DISTRICT RESIDENTS ONLY.

Information: Children must be registered by a parent or legal guardian to participate in the after-school Homework Center. This is a one-time registration for the 2018-2019 school year beginning on September 4, 2018. A certified teacher is available to assist children with their homework. Please review the Homework Center rules with your children. By working together, we can provide a good learning environment for our children.

Homework Center Hours:

MONDAYS & WEDNESDAYS ONLY, 3:30 – 5:00 PM (school days only)

If the Baldwin School District has no school, the Homework Center will also be closed. The Homework Center begins Monday, September 17, 2018.

Assistance is on a first-come first-serve basis.

Homework Center Rules:

- All students must sign in for every visit.
- All students must do homework or school-related work in the Homework Center.
- Once a student leaves the Homework Center, they will not be allowed to re-enter.
- Homework Help is for grades 1-6 (no younger siblings please).
- Computers are for typing only.
- Please be quiet and considerate of all students.
- No food or drink is permitted.

Please note: All children under the age of 10 must have a parent or caregiver present in the Library. Disruptive students may be asked to leave the Homework Center. If the child remains a disturbance in the Library, the child may be asked to leave the Library.

In registering my child for the Homework Center, I verify I am aware of the Homework Center hours and rules and will review the Homework Center rules with my child.
